Our Women's Outreach Worker provides trauma informed, feminist-based support both individually and in groups for women which includes transgender, two spirit, and gender diverse individuals, who have experienced violence, abuse, or threats. She provides emotional and practical support for women as they navigate the impacts of the trauma resulting from abusive or violent experiences.

More specifically, she:

- Provides practical support for women based on their needs, which includes helping with forms/applications, navigating/accessing services, accessing legal aid/clinics etc.;
- Provides on-going emotional support while working through the various challenges clients may be facing;
- Assists women through referrals to appropriate services;
- Provides local transportation, accompaniment and advocacy as needed for medical, legal or social services appointments, and to the nearest transition house.
